# ARGENTINE RED WINES



## BODEGA LUIGI BOSCA

The Arizu Family, of European heritage in the Basque country, arrived in Argentina in 1890 and founded Bodega Luigi Bosca together with the Bosca Family in 1901, It is located in the Department of Luján de Cuyo, Argentina. Luigi Bosca launches the first Malbec DOC. in Argentina and Latin America.

## LUIGI BOSCA MALBEC

Red wine of purplish red color, bright and young. with very expressive aromas reminiscent of fresh red fruit like cherry and blackberry, and spices notes and very delicate floral. It is straight forward and fluid on the palate, with lively tannins. It is intense and pleasant in the mouth.

## RESERVA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The Luigi Bosca, Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits a ruby red color, bright, clean. Fresh, velvety fruity. Aromas of red and black fruits, violets and chocolate. Of great structure and body, a wine of character and exquisite elegance. It remains 14 months in French oak barrels and can be kept for about 10 years.

## BODEGA NAVARRO CORREAS

Dedicated to viticulture since 1798 Don Juan de Dios Correas planted his first vines at the base of the Andes mountain range. Today it has 36 hectares in the district of Agrelo, Mendoza, Argentina; it was the place chosen by more than 9 generations.

## NAVARRO CORREAS MALBEC

Of an intense red color, this wine features flavors of blackberries, quince and spice as well as a medium body and silky tannins. The owner of a superb fruity character and a lingering finish.

## NAVARRO CORREAS CABERNET SAUVIGNON

At sight, ruby in color with violet hues. On the nose, red fruits such as blackberry, red pepper and spices such as white pepper. In the mouth, soft tannins. Good balance between fruit and sweetness. Fresh and long finish.

## ALEGORIA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Intense red color with ruby hints. Aromas and flavors of plums, blackcurrant with soft notes of pepper. Notes of tobacco add complexity. Great structure, firm and round tannins with long finish.

## ALEGORIA MALBEC

A wine of an intense purplish red color exhibiting aromas and flavors of plums, blackberries, figs and black cherries. Its spicy notes of liquorice, cinnamon and clove from its aging in oak all contribute to its overall complexity. Great structure, firm ripe tannins and outstanding balance.

## ESCORIHUELA GASCON PINOT NOIR

Bright cherry red with garnet reflections. The nose displays a good flow of fruit in which cherries, blueberries and blackberries stand out along with earthy tones and fresh mushroom. The aging provides subtle hints of spice. On the palate it is dry and sober, flowing with a medium and delicate body. It is somewhat warm like a good warm climate wine and thanks to a refreshing acidity it achieves a tasty balance with a long finish with round tannins.

## BODEGA ALTOS DE LAS HORMIGAS

In 1995, with the vision of Alberto Antonini, renowned Italian oenologist and Antonio Morescalchi founded in the district of Carrizal in Luján de Cuyo. Farm surrounded by colonies of countless ants.

### ALTOS DE LAS HORMIGAS CLASSIC MALBEC

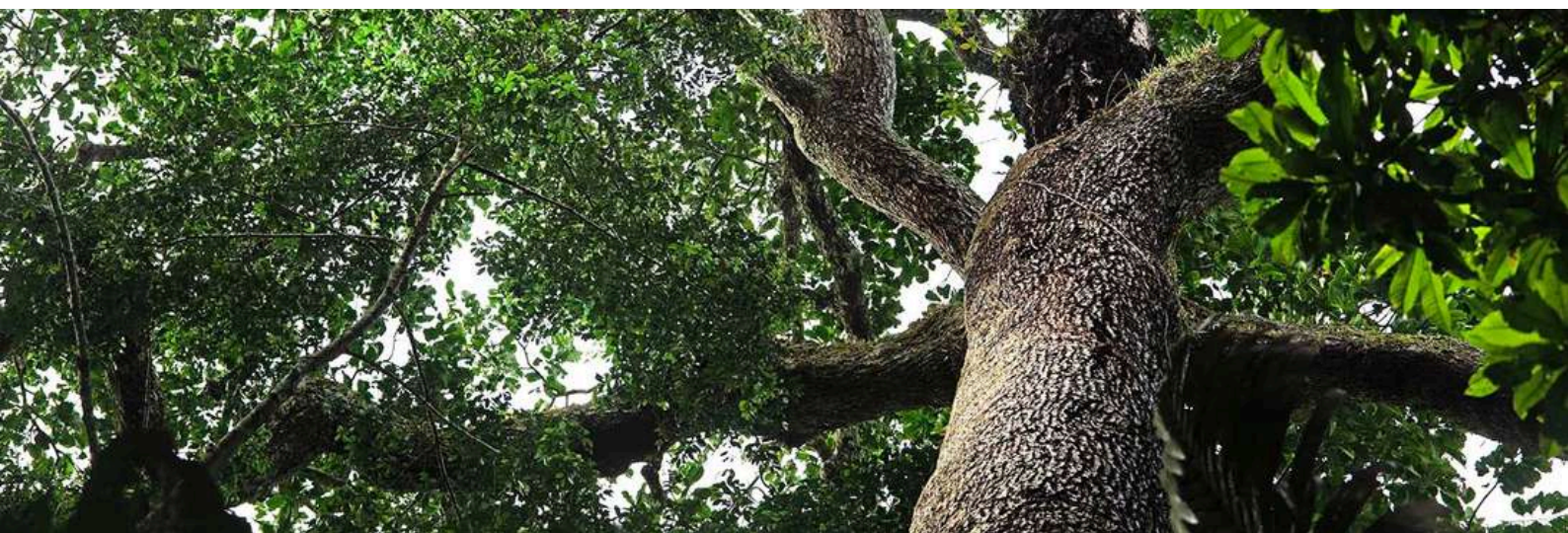
Deep violet-red color. It shows a very expressive nose, with fruity notes of raspberries and fresh plums along with spiced notes, white pepper stands out. The mouth experience begins with spices, followed by a feeling of vitality in the tannins, good structure, weight, finesse and a long and juicy finish.

### ALTOS DE LAS HORMIGAS MALBEC RESERVA

It has a deep ruby red color with violet hues; it is lively and attractive. The nose is complex, expressive and aromatic. This is a vertical Malbec with very fine grain tannins and velvety texture. The palate shows abundant ripe fruit notes and its oak aging only appears subtly in the finish. A long and persistent wine that will open in the glass with a very present character of the place.

## BODEGA RUTINI

In 1925. Rutini became the first winery to plant vineyards in the Uco Valley, Mendoza, his principal oenologist is Mariano Di Paola, one of the 30 best oenologists in the world according to the magazine Decanter.

## TRUMPETER MALBEC

Bright violet red, seductive fruity plum aromas and spice profile (cinnamon, cardamom, blackpepper). This red wine has great body and its lively structure accentuates intense tannins with a velvety aftertaste.

## TRUMPETER MERLOT

Dark ruby red with dense purple tones. Intense and concentrated nose with black cherry jam aromas, and tobacco and vanilla notes. Mouth feel is soft and inviting, with ripe cherry and plums and a pleasant and persistent aftertaste.

## RUTINI MALBEC

Intense red, with bluish hues. The nose is fruity with notes of plum, vanilla, and anise; while in the mouth the plum accents are rearmend. The tannins, very present but kind, highlight its personality.

## RUTINI MERLOT

Intense red with a violet hue. It gives a generous and aromatic nose (red and black fruits, such as blackberry) and suggestive accents of cocoa and tobacco. Firm on the palate, he owns a great body, complex and elegant at the same time. A classic Argentine varietal red.

## BODEGA ERRAZURIZ

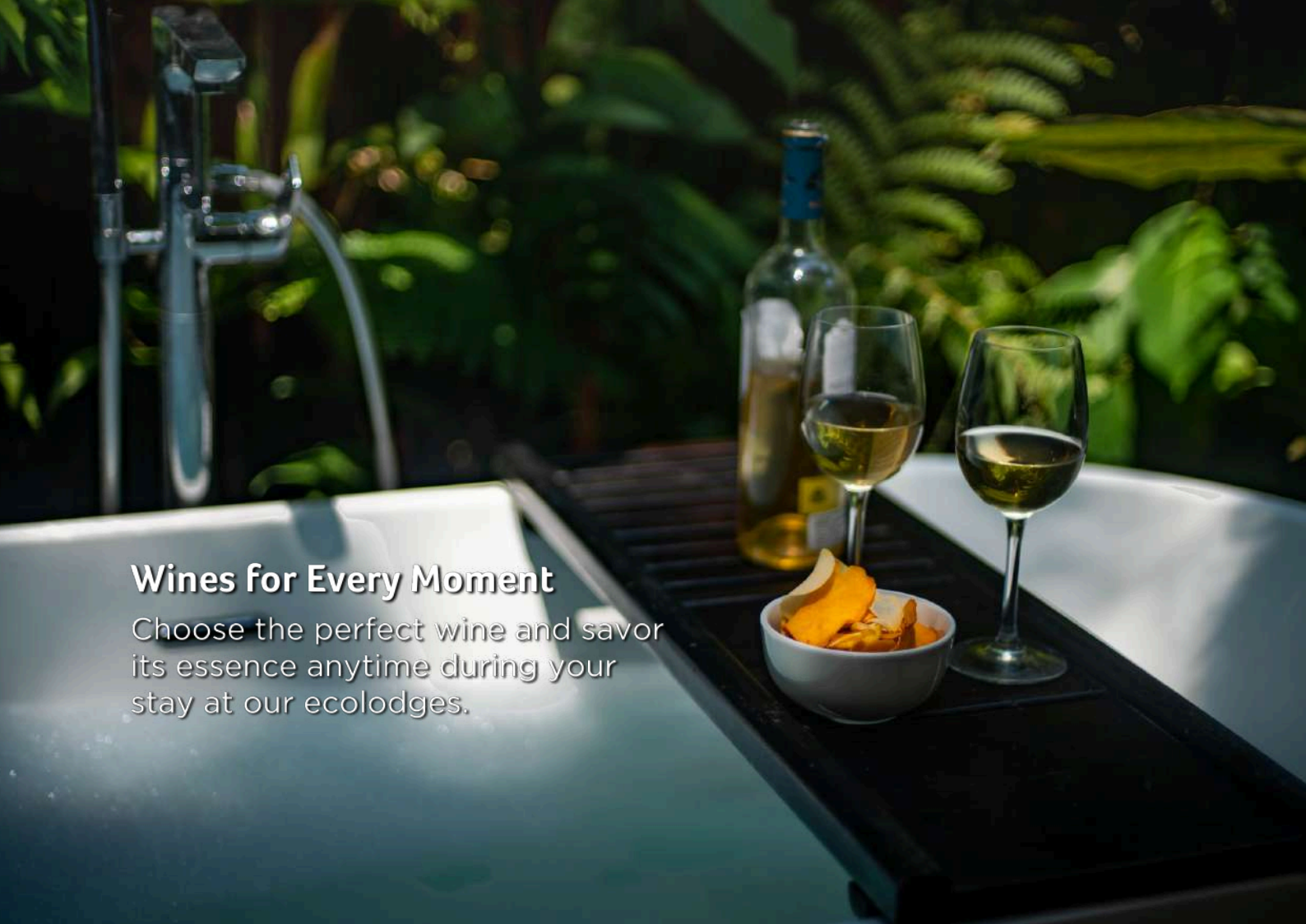
Don Maximiano Errazuriz, a Chilean of Basque Spanish origin, founded Viña Errazuriz in 1870 in Panquehue planting the first French vines in the Aconcagua Valley.

## ERRAZURRIZ RESERVA CARMENERE

Beautiful cherry red color of medium intensity. On the nose, aromas of red roasted pepper. Tobacco, dill, and mushrooms are complimented by a subtle note of blackberries and cherries. On the palate, the wine shows fresh and delicate flavors of cherry and plum complimented by a touch of spice, chocolate and roasted coffee beans .Very pleasant and smooth in the mouth, it is a wine with good structure and refreshing acidity, with excellent persistence.

# PERUVIAN RED WINES



## BODEGA TACAMA

In 1540 Francisco de Carabantes created the Tacama vineyard, the oldest in Peru, in Ica with vines from the Canary Islands.

### TACAMA SELECCION ESPECIAL

It evokes fruits, plums, licorice, and especially perfectly ripe grapes; it has peppery notes that highlight its richness and radiance. The tannins are wrapped and have no aggressiveness. The finish is long and aromatic, made with the varieties: Tannat, originally from southwestern France and Petit Verdot de Medoc.

## BODEGA TABERNERO

In 1987 Tabernero was founded in the Chincha Valley, province of Ica, 125 miles south of Lima, in 1930 it was acquired by the Rotondo family.

### GRAN TINTO FINA RESERVA MALBEC-MERLOT

Cherry red covered with raspberry tones. It is very expressive in the nose, highlighting black fruits such as blackberry, cherries. Lilium flower, red pepper and with a background of blackberry jam. In the mouth, it is fresh and medium-bodied with a mild mineral flavor, pleasant tannins, and a long aftertaste.

## BODEGA INTIPALKA - QUEIROLO

Intipalka means Valley of the Sun in Quechua, in reference to the Valley of Ica where these Vineyards of the Bodega Santiago Queirolo are located.

## INTIPALKA RESERVA MALBEC - MERLOT

Intense red with violet nuances, with a combination of fresh fruit aromas, contributed by Malbec, with other denser and more mature aromas contributed by Merlot. Soft tannins and fine weft.

# WHITE WINES



## NAVARRO CORREAS COLECCION PRIVADA SAUVIGNON BLANC

Bodega Navarro Correa, Argentina, Greenish yellow with aromas of fresh herbs and tropical fruits such as passion fruit. Intense and fresh lingering flavor.

## ANDELUNA RAÍCES CHARDONNAY

Bodega Andeluna, of a yellow color with greenish hues, this is a wine bursting with aromas and flavors of apples, peaches and apricots. An unctuous texture and delicate notes of toast that combine very well with its crisp and lengthy finish.

## INTIPALKA SAUVIGNON BLANC

Pale yellow color with greenish edges. Expressive aroma with citrus, apple and peach notes. In the mouth, refreshing, lively and with good acidity, a light structure with a long and exquisite finish. Leg Medal Concours Mondial du Sauvignon 2016.

## ERRAZURIS RESERVA CHARDONNAY

Silver yellow color with greenish hues. On the nose, this Sauvignon Blanc displays herbaceous notes such as tomato leaves, a subtle green chili aroma along with citrus notes that reminds of tangerine peel and lemon peel. The palate reveals citrus and herbal notes that combine to create a very refreshing and crispy composition. Good persistence, excellent acidity that adds verticality to the wine, enhancing its most refreshing profile.

## MARQUES DE RISCAL RUEDA

A bright, straw-yellow coloured wine. As you expect from a verdeo wine on the nose it has high aromatic intensity, with tropical fruit and hints of fennel and fresh grass. In the mouth it is both syrupy smooth and refreshing with a slightly bitter finish which is typical of the variety making it long and pleasant to drink. Overall it is a fresh, well-balanced wine. ## BLANCO DE BLANCOS SAUVIGNON BLANC VIOGNIER CHARDONNAY

Pale yellow color, with fruity aromas of pear, apple, and quince, persistent with great harmony between fruit and freshness. Medalle Argent Citadelles du Vin, France 2016. International Wine Challenge 2015. Golden medal Expovino 2015. Bacchus 2018 Golden medal.

## EL CIRCO GARNACHA PAYASO - ROSE

It is a fresh and fruity rosé wine made with Garnacha grapes. Pale pink in color, it has refreshing acidity and a light flavor on the palate, presenting delicate aromas of red fruits such as strawberries and raspberries, along with subtle floral notes

# SPARKLING WINES



## NAVARRO CORREA EXTRA BRUT

Made with Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes Located in Tupungato and Luján de Cuyo with alluvial soils with the presence of boulders and clay, it is a pale yellow wine with attractive fruity and floral aromas of peaches, apricots and pineapple, being fresh in the mouth with balanced acidity.

## RICADONNA PROSECO X 200 ML.

Fruity and floral aroma, with notes of citrus and apple peel.

## TACAMA ORQUÍDEA NEGRA BRUT

After the production of a aromatic wine with Chenin grapes, comes the second fermentation that will generate the effervescence of the wine and a very intense aromatic complexity. It has a light yellow with green nuances. On the nose there are delicate aromas of white flowers and dried fruits, almonds and hazelnuts. In the mouth the sensations are more of white fruits, peach and plum. A fresh and balanced wine, with bubbles that spread in the mouth.
